Your self-introduction should include the following information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your statement for wanting to be friends• Your name, age, school, and grade.• Your nationality and any languages you speak• Your family• Your contact information including your address, cell phone number, and your e-mail• Questions that you want the international student to answer (age, school, hometown, languages they speak, family, contact information etc.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I can write basic information about myself, my address, phone number, and favorite colors in the form of letter, postcard, and e-mail.• I can write a letter / postcard, or e-mail to ask the information about someone's address, phone number, favorite colors, hometown, family etc.
